

Introduction



This Tourist Guide aims to provide you, the tourist, with the best experience of your life. In the first section, 'Discovering Sao Paulo,' you will be introduced to the best attractions in the state of Sao Paulo, from rural to urban, immersing you in the local culture known for its hospitality. Following that, the Halal concept for hotels and restaurants in Sao Paulo is described through category C - Muslim-Friendly - adopted by some hotels and restaurants featured in this publication. This category has specific conditions to accommodate the Muslim audience, which will be explained on the "Halal Classification" page.

Soon after, the guide reaches its main part, with recommendations divided into four regions: Capital of Sao Paulo, Metropolitan Region, Countryside of Sao Paulo, and Coast of Sao Paulo. The Capital also includes some subsections defined as: downtown, north, south, east, and west. Meanwhile, the coastal area is subdivided based on three tourist regions of the state: Atlantic Forest Coast, Lagamar, and Northern Coast of Sao Paulo.

The fourth part of the Guide contains a section with Consulates and Embassies, in case you need to address any more bureaucratic matters. Following that, the 'Prayer Times' are made available through a link where you can input the location of the nearest mosque and identify the exact times for your prayers.

Information about airports and shopping malls with prayer rooms is also available in the penultimate section of this material, to assist you in practicing your faith even when far from your home country. It's the + Islam section. Finally, the material provides 'Useful Phone Numbers,' a telephone directory with emergency contacts for international banks, police stations, hospitals, and more, designed to help you in times of need. This introduction is intended to warmly welcome you and immerse you in a high-quality tourist experience. So, make the most of this material.

Halal Classification for Hotels and Restaurants





The Muslim-Friendly concept is used to classify destinations worldwide that are capable of welcoming Muslim tourists and visitors.

A Muslim-Friendly establishment provides food accommodation services that respect the principles and behaviors consistent with the Islamic faith. To achieve this classification, there are three certification categories for hotels and restaurants, namely:



- Category A Advanced Service Scale
- Category B Moderate Service Scale
- Category C Basic Service Scale

These categories define which services can be adopted by each establishment. In Category C, the Basic Scale for Halal Tourism chosen for the state of Sao Paulo, the following facilities are required:

- Options for Halal food upon request. (Halal-certified kitchen or provision of Halal food or a list of local Halal restaurants):
- 2- Removal of alcohol from the minibar upon request;
- Indication of the Qibla direction;
- Sajjadas (Prayer mats) and prayer schedule upon request;
- 5- A trained team knowledgeable about the principles of Halal Tourism awareness.

As for the other categories, they can be adopted by any establishment as long as they meet the requirements established by Islamic authorities and Halal standards.

Discovering Sao Paulo

The state of Sao Paulo is undoubtedly the gateway to Brazil. Chances are you've experienced a situation like this, even indirectly, Sao Paulo was there, whether it was part of a flight itinerary to any other Brazilian state or in events of public interest.

But what is it about this state that's so special,

capable of capturing the attention of Brazil and the world, to the extent that it has become a highlight and reference? How about discovering more about Sao Paulo and being convinced to visit this unique part of Brazil?

In first place, Sao Paulo boasts the largest capital in Latin America, a city bearing the

same name. This fact justifies the attraction of numerous investments, and when combined with the economy and industry of the other 644 municipalities, Sao Paulo becomes the largest economic and industrial center in the Southern Hemisphere. That's right, as you just read: Sao Paulo is a great place for business. What's more, if the state were a country, it would be the 21st largest economy in the world!

Sao Paulo is home to approximately 46 million people, who welcome visitors from all over the world, whether those who come to visit iconic places like the Municipal Market, known as the "Mercadão," or aspire to make this land a place of personal prosperity and professional achievement.

The tourism scene in Sao Paulo will be explored further in this guide, but here are some intriguing features to pique your interest: there are 210 tourist cities offering diverse cultural, culinary, and natural attractions; 410 hotels in the capital; 630 kilometers of beaches; 4,200 kilometers of navigable rivers and 50 lakes; and more than 100 parks and protected areas, including the Atlantic Forest.

Did you enjoy it? And it doesn't stop there!

In terms of infrastructure and logistics, Sao Paulo boasts the largest port in Latin America, in Santos, which reported net financial revenues equivalent to R\$136.5 million last year. Sao Paulo is home to 25% of all higher education institutions in Brazil, with the University of Sao Paulo (USP) accounting for over 20% of Brazilian scientific production. Furthermore, the state

boasts 35,000 kilometers of highways, including 19 of the top 20 in the country.

Sao Paulo also hosts the largest complex of bus terminals, with 89 platforms and 300 bus lines serving 1,033 cities, according to Socicam, the concessionaire responsible for managing the bus terminals.

It's worth noting that Sao Paulo has the largest network of regular airports with commercial flights in Brazil, with nine operations in nine municipalities: Araçatuba, Bauru (Arealva), Campinas (Viracopos), Marília, Presidente Prudente, Ribeirao Preto, Sao José do Rio Preto, Sao Paulo (Congonhas), and Guarulhos.

There are plenty of transportation options within the state of Sao Paulo. Now, all that's left to do is pick the right date to visit Sao Paulo. How about New Year's Eve? It's one of the most beautiful and sought-after events for tourism! You've just learned a bit about Sao Paulo, and perhaps you've been pleasantly surprised. Keep enjoying the Tourist Guide because there's much more to discover and add to your itinerary.




Sao Paulo Capital
